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**Subject: Annual District Sports**

As you are aware the Annual Sports' Day is scheduled to take place on February 28, 2009, at the National Stadium beginning at 9:00 a.m. This year we are trying to get more Scouts, Cub Scouts and Beaver Scouts involved. Each Group is allowed to enter two athletes per event.

On the Sports Day we are planning to include such fun events as: knot relays, three-legged races, obstacle races, lime/egg and spoon races, sack races, etc. Competitors should be at the Stadium by 8:30 a.m. and should wear their Group colours.

In order to ensure that the events are done in a systematic manner we are asking each Group to submit the names of at least two persons who can either be a Leader or Parent to assist the organising committee with the day's activity.

Spectators should be in activity wear. There is an admission charge of \$1.00 **per person**. Refreshments will be on sale.

The divisions are:

Under 7 those born in 2001 and after

Under 9 1999 and 2000

Under 11 1997 and 1998

Under 13 1996 and 1997

Under 15 1994 and 1995

Fifteen and over 1993 and before

The events to be contested are:

Under 7 50m, 80m standing broad jump

Under 9 80 m, 100 m, 200 m, long jump, relay

Under 11 100 m, 200 m, 400m, long jump, relay

Under 13                      100 m, 200 m , 400m, long jump, relay  
Under 15                      100 m, 200 m , 400m, long jump, relay  
Fifteen and over            100 m, 200 m , 400m, long jump, relay  
Open events                800m Scouts, 600 m (Cub Scouts only), tug-o-war  
Leaders' and parents' races

Points will be awarded as follows: **7 5 3 1**  
Relay                                **14 10 6 2**

The names of those leaders who are willing to help on the day of the sports should be submitted as soon as possible to your Deputy District Commissioner.

In order to speed up the registration process we are requesting that you complete the enclosed forms by ticking (✓) the event for which the child has entered. Those boys who have been chosen as reserves, should also be listed on the forms. Please return completed forms to your DDC's by Friday, February 07, so that a master list can be completed.

This activity is the major event on the District calendar and you are urged to make every effort to attend and to participate as is appropriate. Your cooperation is requested.
