# THE SCOUT UNIFORM

## THE SCOUT UNIFORM

The Scout Uniform consist of a khaki Scout shirt (short sleeves), navy blue pants, navy blue socks, black shoes, green beret, beret pin, Scout belt, scarf, woggle, lanyard, whistle (optional), Scout Membership Badge and Barbados Badge. For Sea Scouts, a white Scout shirt is used instead of khaki and a blue beret is used instead of a green one. All of these items are available at the Scout Shop, with the exceptions of the shoes, socks and scarf. The Troop scarf is presented to the recruit at his investiture ceremony, and remains the property of the Troop. This means that if a Scout leaves the Troop, he will be required to return the Troop scarf.

The beret is worn with the pin over the left eye and the beret sloped to the right. The lanyard is worn around the neck (under the scarf) with the loose end in the left shirt pocket (if a Scout has a whistle it should be attached to the end of the lanyard). The Scout Membership Badge is worn on the left shirt pocket in the centre, and the Barbados Badge above the right shirt pocket. The Troop Name Tape (if available) is worn at the top of the right shirt sleeve, with the District Badge under it, and the Patrol Badge under the District Badge.



The Progressive Training Award Badge (Scout Award, Pathfinder Award, Explorer Award or Chief Scout's Award) is worn on the right shirt pocket in the centre, and the Chief Scout's Challenge Badge above the left shirt pocket. The S.P.L., P.L. or A.P.L. Badge is worn on the left shirt pocket under the Scout Membership Badge, and the Leadership Award on the right shirt pocket flap. The Patrol Activity Award can be either a woggle or a badge. The woggle is worn on the scarf in place of the regular woggle and the badge is worn on the left shirt pocket flap.

Proficiency Badges are worn on the left shirt sleeve. They are grouped in fours in the shape of a diamond. They are worn in the following order: Collective Achievement Badges, Service and Instructor



Badges, and Interest and Pursuit Badges. When their are less than four badges, they are place in the following order: the first badge at the top of the "diamond"; the second badge at the bottom of the "diamond"; and the third badge (if available) at the left of the "diamond".
