### Photograph

You are required to submit 2 passport size photographs.

### Flag

All contingent would be required to bring along 3 flags (Size 5'X 4') of their country to be used at the Jamboree.

### Contingent Exhibition

All contingent would be allotted space to mount an exhibition of tourism and scouting of their country.

### Gilwell Reunion

As part of the Jamboree Programme there would be a Gilwell Reunion. The cost to attend this event would be US\$25.

### Equipment

Each troop would be given 2 tables, 4 chairs, 5 buckets and a fly sheet to be used to set up their kitchen and dining room area. Wood would be available to build additional camp gadgets. Contingent would have to provide their own rope.

Stove would be available for rental at a cost of US\$50 for the period of the Jamboree. Cooking gas would be available for sale at a cost of US\$15 for a 20lbs cylinder.

### Internet

Internet would be available throughout the Jamboree at a cost of US\$2.00 per hour

### Banking Facility

A bank would be on site to facilitate the changing of foreign currency to Guyana dollars. US\$1.00 = G\$200.

### Supermarket

A well stock Supermarket would be onsite.

### General

All contingent is required to present at least three cultural items at the sub-camp concert. Contingent is encouraged to bring along costumes and their national dress for a cultural presentation.

Swimming gear is required for one of the off -site tours.

### Travelling Arrangements

Contingents are required to immediately submit their travelling arrangements.
